

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Carlin Bay Property Owners

Our water system violated drinking water requirements over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct these situations.

**We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During April 2015 we did not monitor or test for Coliform Bacteria and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time. We sampled for April's Coliform Bacteria on March 30. As a consequence we were credited with two coliform samples for March and no samples for April.*

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. The table below lists the contaminant we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for Coliform Bacteria, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

Contaminant	Required sampling frequency	Number of samples taken	When samples should have been taken	When samples were taken
Coliform Bacteria	Monthly	12	April 2015	30 March 2015

What is being done?

We will not monitor for coliform except in the month that is required even if it is one day prior to the required month.
